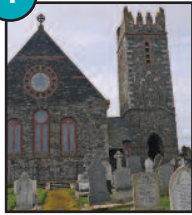

Whether or not you are visitors to our shores or Manx residents, I hope you will take the opportunity to visit these wonderful venues and relax and enjoy the magnificent displays.

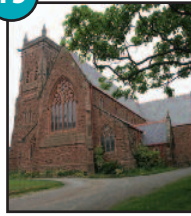

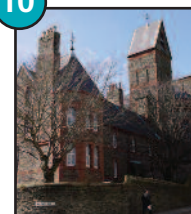

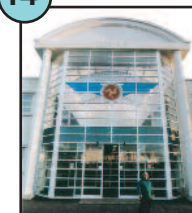
